- 5 In which year was the yellow jersey introduced?
- 6 He won the Tour once and the climber's prize five times. He was called the Eagle of Toledo. What is his name?
- 7 The 1975 Tour started in Charleroi. In which country is that?
- 8 Which famous Tour riders are, or were, known by the nicknames:
(a) Nanard?
(b) Poupou?
(c) Cri-Cri?
- 9 The Tour often covers stretches of very rough road which are also used in a classic race called 'the Hell of the North'. Where does that race start and finish?
- 10 Who is the only Dutch rider to have won the Tour?
- 11 Is the 1978 Tour the 63rd, the 65th or the 68th?
- 12 What title is given to the rider who finishes Tour in the last place on general classification?
